Participating for the first time in international competitions:

1 ° - provide lots of information

ESSENTIAL COMMUNICATION



- How many people has the team (coach, athletes, others - men or women)
- Where, how and when the team arrives in town
- Who is the main contact person (e-mail and telephone contacts)
- Whether the team has own equipment or needs to rent their boats

THE RULES OF THE CANOE

and behavior in an international environment

2° - how to participate at the event

ESSENTIAL MOMENTS OF THE TRIP

- **Registration** (pay attention to deadlines and categories)
- **Accreditation** (pay attention to substitutions and ALWAYS communicate any withdrawals)
- **Withdrawal/vision of racing program**
- Constant monitoring of the racing program and possible changes
- **Boat weight control**
- **Qualifying**
- **Awards** (if any)
- **Withdrawal / vision results**


3° - What should the team leader do

- ❖ Greet / say goodbye to the event organiser
- ❖ Participate in meetings
- ❖ Represent the team at any time of competition

THE RULES OF THE CANOE

5° - What must the athlete do

- Know the programs of their own races
- Check the weight of the boat
- NEVER forget your paddle and other accessories
- Know the measurements of their position in the boat
- Warming up before the race
- Reach in advance the race departure point
- Listen to the judges
- Not be an obstacle for the other races in progress



THE RULES OF THE CANOE

and behavior in an international environment

6° - When the team leader can be absent from the competition

- When their athletes are not racing.

In case of necessity, must delegate another team leader or coach



THE RULES OF THE CANOE

and behavior in an international environment

7° - When the coach can be absent from the competition

- When their athletes are not racing

8° - When an athlete can be absent from the competition

- NEVER

He can relax in the three hours before race start and after the last race of the day.





THE RULES OF THE CANOE

and behavior in an international environment

9 ° - Good conduct:

- Always carry a set of numbers from n. 1 to n. 9
- Bring the basic tools to fix the rudder cables, footrests and seat
- Have copies of documents of all participants in the trip
- Have medical insurance for all participants of the trip
- Have more contact details of the organiser of the event
- Notify the organisation when there are delays, accidents, injuries
